

[Philippine Communist Leadership Orders Guerrillas to Go](#)

After Chinese Firms: Radio Free Asia: 14 OCT 2020: "The outlawed Philippine communist party directed its armed wing on Wednesday to target Chinese companies involved in infrastructure projects, including state-backed firms that the United States has blacklisted for their part in Beijing's militarization in the South China Sea.

The communists announced the move six weeks after the Philippine government – their enemy for the past half-century – declared that it would not follow Washington's lead by cutting ties with firms involved in China's building of artificial islands and military installations in the disputed waterway. At least one of those 24 firms sanctioned by the U.S. is involved in Philippine infrastructure projects.

In a statement issued Wednesday, the Communist Party of the Philippines (CPP) did not name the Chinese firms, but said they were involved in the construction of Chinese installations and "in the plunder and destruction of Philippine marine resources in the West Philippine Sea, in violation of Philippine sovereignty." To this day Mao caps, with a red star emblazoned on the front against a field of green, are popular among them."



Let's spin the Evil wheel of Evil and see where else we might pursue this approach....How about...hum.. here.



"The seizure of Chinese-run mines in **Kyrgyzstan** amid ongoing protests has highlighted the risks to business in region, fueling China's desire to promote its private security companies (PSCs). So far, six PSCs are active in Central Asia, including the controversial Xinjiang-based Frontier Services Group, which is making inroads in **Kazakhstan's** logistics market. Nevertheless, significant legal hurdles remain. As Chinese PSCs expand their operations, they continue to partner with local groups to gain further market access, as well as connections to officials in the interior ministry. But if Chinese PSCs continue to expand operations, Sinophobic sentiments—already widespread across the region—may spark a cycle of escalating securitization that will undermine China's long-term interests."



“The total value of China’s stock market has climbed to a record high of more than \$10tn, as the country’s accelerating economic recovery propelled it past the previous peak hit during an equities bubble five years ago. That is above the \$10.05tn pinnacle hit in June 2015 just before a rout sparked by a crackdown on leveraged trading, which resulted in the Chinese market plunging by half.”

“Compared to five years ago there have been some major changes,” said Bruce Pang, head of macro and strategy research at investment bank China Renaissance. Mr Pang said the use of margin lending to buy equities was far less prevalent now than in 2015, when Chinese markets rallied by more than 100 per cent before collapsing share prices triggered waves of forced selling.
